- 3. Book covers are recommended for ALL SCHOOL-OWNED HARD-COVER BOOKS. Stretchable fabric book covers work great; they can be washed and re-used each year!
- 4. **Grades 3-8 Assignment Notebook** each Grade 3-8 student will be charged for an assignment notebook when enrolling via TADS; the notebook will be picked up on Registration Day.
